RECRUITMENT AT BRH

Shortages of clinicians in various disciplines are still a challenge, and recruitment of medical staff remains a priority at Blanche River Health. Recruiters have been busy travelling the province and even the UK to promote Blanche River Health and the local area to medical professionals. Government programs and incentives have been used, and we are happy to report that 33 new clinicians have been recruited to Blanche River Health in the last year. Our reliance on temporary agency staffing has decreased by 10 positions.

ED CLOSURE AT OUR ENGLEHART SITE

On March 5, we had to make the difficult decision to temporarily close the Emergency Department (ED) at our Englehart site, due to a shortage of physicians. We thank the residents of Englehart and surrounding areas for the patience and understanding they showed our staff during the 48 hour closure. While we continue to actively recruit physicians from all corners, we remain vulnerable to such closures for the time being.



BLANCHE RIVER HEALTH FOUNDATION
